Obstacle Course Challenges

26. Senior level 2 Course for riders 16 and over – 8-10 obstacles



Registration Information

Entry fee per class: \$10 day of show. Pre-registration and discount entries must be received by noon, the Wednesday before the show or no discount will apply. Blank entry forms are available to download and to send along with your check. You, of course, may join in additional classes on the day of the show. Send checks made out to Linda Stanier (NOT ROSE FARM) Sorry for the yelling. Add a \$8 administration fee to your total entry amount. For example, if you sign up for 6 classes, with the coupon your total would be $\$48 + \$10 = \$58$. Seven classes would total $\$56 + \$10 = \$66$.

Show Information

Registration opens at 8:00 am. Schooling starts at 8:30 am. Show starts at 9:00 am. Park in designated areas. People will be here to direct you.

1. All participants must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets in English classes and while mounted. Show attire not required. A neat and tidy appearance is acceptable. Jackets will be excused in the hottest months. English- boots, neutral-colored riding pants, riding shirt, polo shirt, or turtleneck, sweater, vest or jacket if needed. Western- boots, jeans, long sleeve shirt, vest, or jacket will be fine. No Sneakers.
2. Classes may be split or combined for size or safety reasons.
3. This is a fun and schooling show, meant for the recreational rider to get out and have some fun at a show without the pressures that can come along with showing. It's also to expose the somewhat sheltered horses and riders to another experience...get them off the farm to a new, yet safe environment, as a stepping stone to bigger shows.
4. You will need a current coggins before you may offload your horse. You may send a copy with your pre-registration or bring it to the show.
5. Snacks, sodas and water are available at the show. You may want to pack a lunch. A food truck is scheduled for the October show. Stalls may be rented for \$20 per day. No pets please. Thanks.
