Come join us for our 2nd Annual Tack Swap and Flea Market on April 26th
9 am – 2 pm at Rose Farm,
9450 Mackall Road, Saint Leonard, Md.

Last year was a big success when we held our flea market in the **first** week of April. We had 30 vendors and approximately 150 shoppers turn out for the 3 hours of the sale. There was a large rush at the end and I sold \$700 of assorted tack and garage sale items; most vendors sold between \$50 and \$200. It was a beautiful day and people made money and the space was **FREE**. Dana had the genius idea to start holding it on the same weekend as the Celtic Festival, the **4th**

Saturday in April, (It will be a little warmer.) and take advantage of the thousands of people driving right by our farm as we are less than ½ mile before Jefferson Patterson Park where the Celtic Festival is held, right on the same road. My vision is to eventually have a VERY big flea market once a year with hundreds of vendors. To help make this a reality, this year vendor space is unlimited in size and is **FREE**. We have a large field and tons of parking. If you have cars, motorcycles, or bikes to sell, bring them!



I sold a ton of tack and horse blankets last year, so clean out your tack rooms, basements and barns and come!

To reserve your space, send your \$20 check to Linda Stanier, PO Box 248, Broomes Island, Md., 20615. Your check needs to be at my PO Box by Thursday, April 24th. Your \$20 secures your spot and will be **refunded in full to you at the end of the Flea Market**. To avoid undue competition, we will only have one of every **brand** category...in other words, one Avon rep, one ReMax agent, one Tupperware vendor. We can, however, have as many people selling yard sale items, baby goods, home hobby items, antiques, etc. as we want. We are

going to run it from 9am to 2pm this year. If there is a large crowd and vendors wish to stay, it can stay open later. I am anticipating an increase in buyer traffic this year and then next year it should really take off as so many people will have seen it this year and made a mental note for next year. In years to come as this gets to be more popular, and I charge for space, the people who helped get this off and running will receive free or major discounts on the vendor space.

To make it more fun, we have contracted **Captain Cook's Bar-B-Q** to bring their truck and sell their delicious meatballs and sandwiches and sodas, so bring your coffee in the morning and enjoy a wonderful pulled pork sandwich, meatballs, etc. for lunch.

You are welcome to sell anything legal. Clean out your barn or garage, sell some of your home crafts, promote your lawn mower repair business, promote your upcoming event, sell some unneeded horse tack, antiques, cars, jewelry, vintage items... you name it. Completely free admission and vendor space makes this an ideal opportunity to make some cash and promote yourself. Set-up begins at 7am on April 26th. Tell your friends and neighbors. We have an indoor arena so we're covered in case of heavy rain. If you have a pop-up canopy, it makes for a nice display as well as shade, but it's not necessary.
